


EXPLANATION

-  NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND—Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the coal-development potential is not rated.
-  AREA OF COAL LEASE ON FEDERAL COAL LAND—Showing coal lease number. Coal-development potential is not rated for this area.
-  AREA OF HIGH COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SUBSURFACE MINING METHODS—Includes areas underlain by the Big Burn coal bed outside the stripping limit, but inside the 1,000-foot (305 m) overburden limit.
