AREA OF PREFERENCE RIGHT LEASE APPLICATION—Showing identification number.

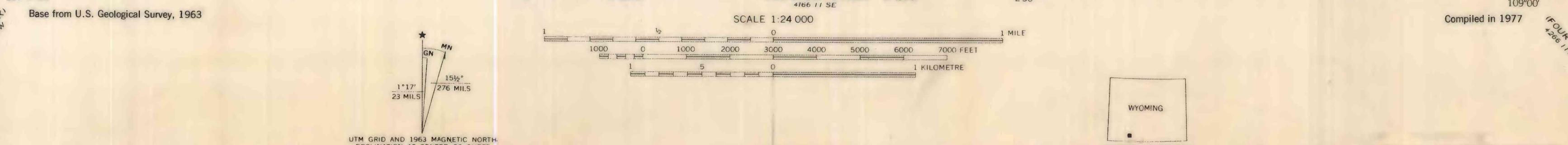
BOUNDARY OF KNOWN RECOVERABLE COAL RESOURCE AREA (KRCRA)—Hachures on side of KRCRA.
