EXPLANATION

TOTAL RESERVE BASE (RB) OF COAL PER SECTION--in millions of short tons, rounded, calculated for each section of Federal land following the guidelines given in U.S. Geol. Survey Bulletin 1450-B. To convert short tons to metric tons, multiply short tons by 0.9072.

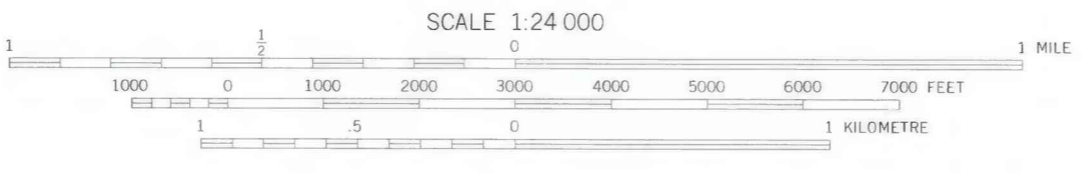
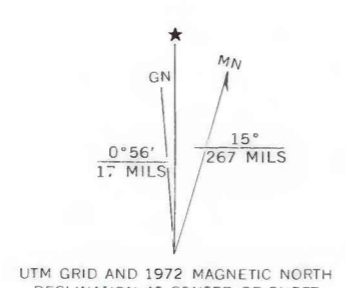
