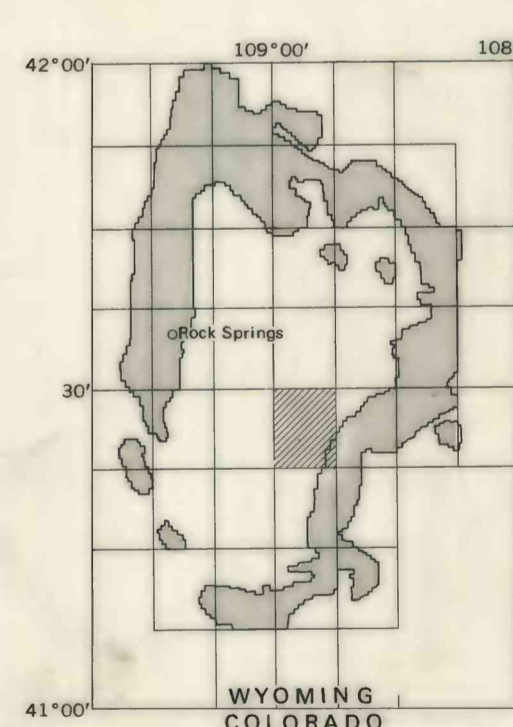

BURNED AND CLINKERED COAL BED--Showing area of baked and fused rock (v symbol). Dotted line indicates the inferred limit of burning.

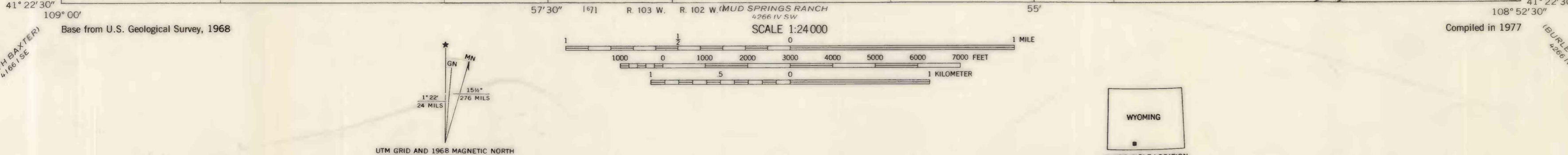
