

EXPLANATION

ISOPACHS—Showing thickness of coal bed, in feet. Dashed where inferred. Isopach interval 5 feet.

DRILL HOLE—Showing thickness of coal bed, in feet. Drill holes which do not intersect the coal bed or from which a coal bed thickness could not be determined are not shown.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP—Line dashed where outcrop is inferred, dotted where concealed. Showing thickness of coal, in feet, or ratio of coal thickness to interburden, in feet, measured at triangle. Showing name of coal bed.


TRACE OF FAULT—Dashed where approximately located; dotted where concealed; queried where inferred. U, up-thrown side; D, downthrown side.

BURNED AND CLINKERED COAL BED—Showing area of baked and fused rock (v symbol). Dotted line indicates inferred limit of burning.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.



