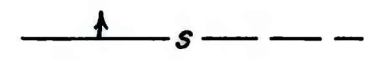
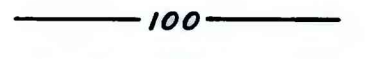

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP-Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Coal bed dashed where inferred or projected.

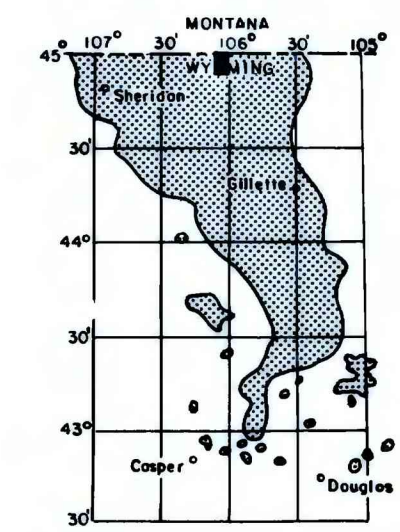


OVERBURDEN ISOPACH-Showing thickness of overburden, in feet, from the surface to top of the coal bed. Isopach interval 100 feet.

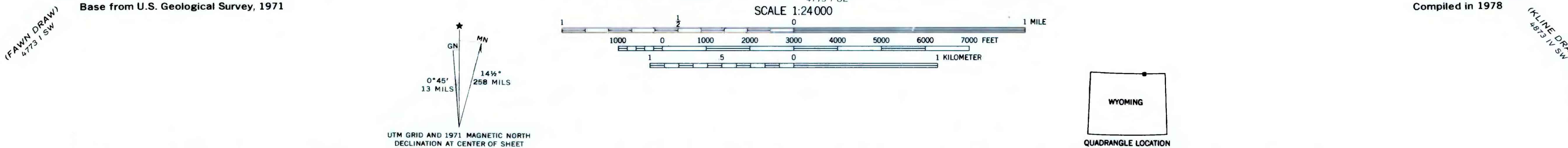


DRILL HOLE-Showing thickness of overburden, in feet, from the surface to top of coal bed.
