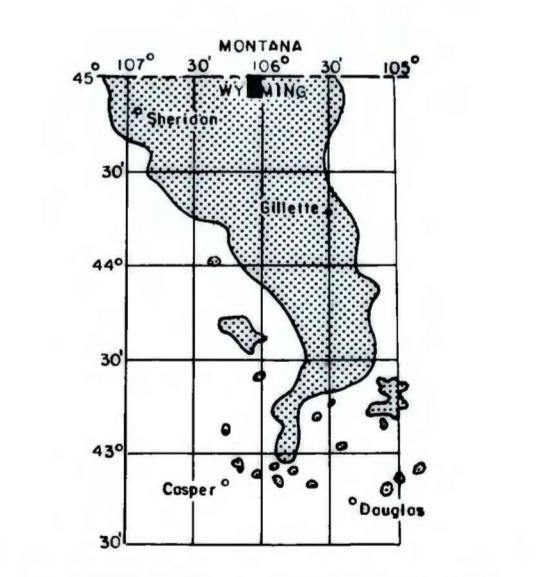

STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed. Contour interval 20 feet (6.1m). Datum is mean sea level.

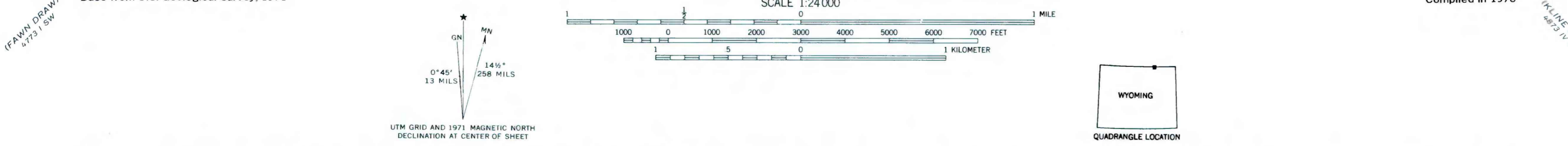
