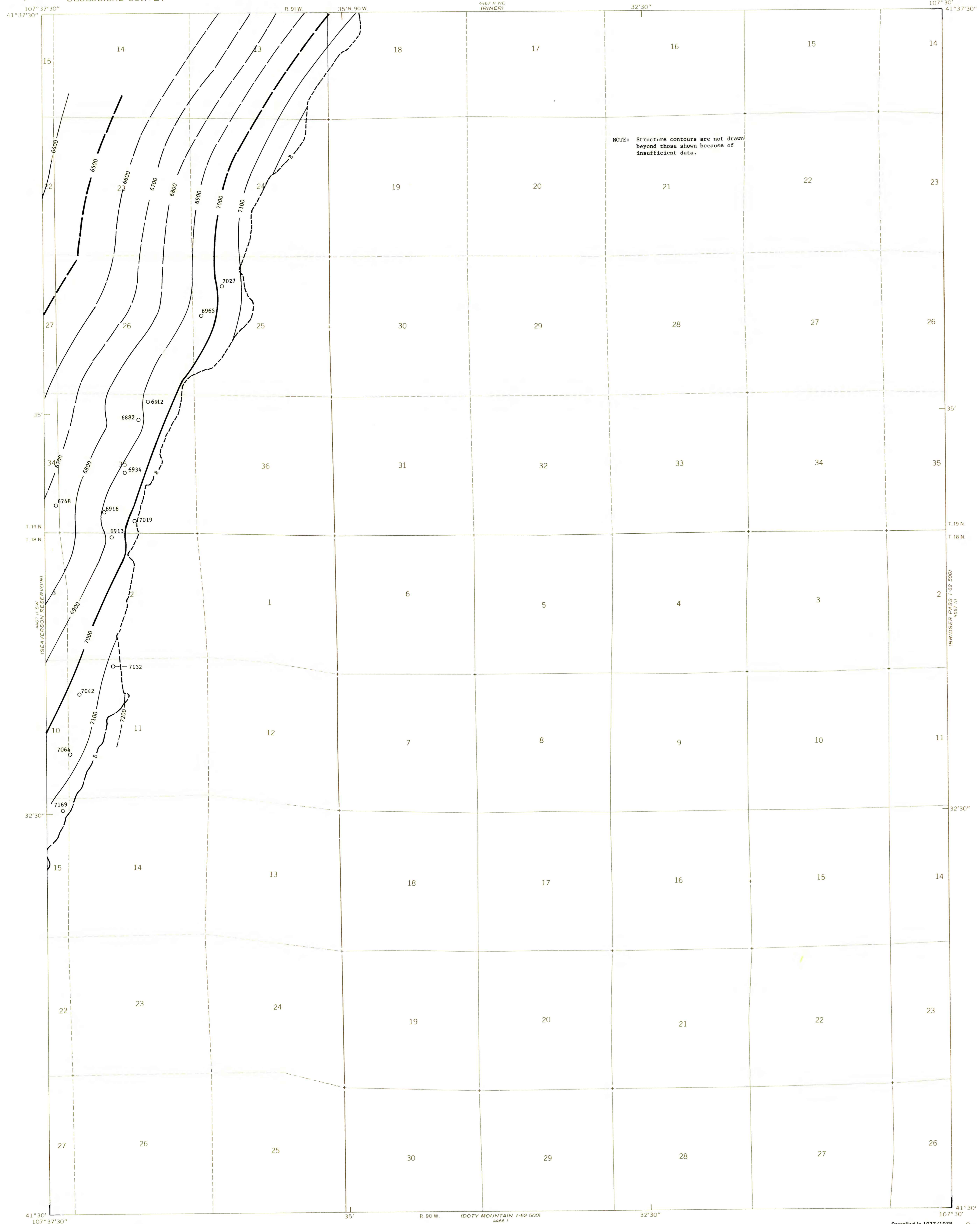

B - B (Fillmore Ranch) of Lower Fort Union Coal Zone

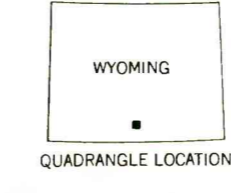
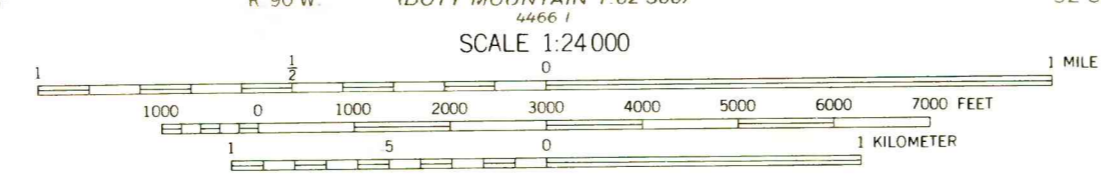
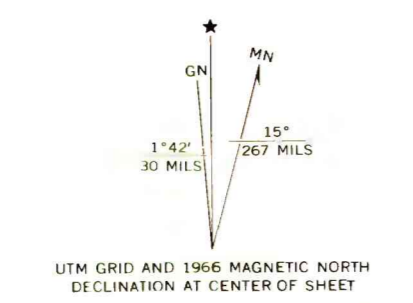
