POINT OF MEASUREMENT - Showing altitude of top of coal bed, and thickness of coal, in feet. Includes all points of measurement other than drill holes.

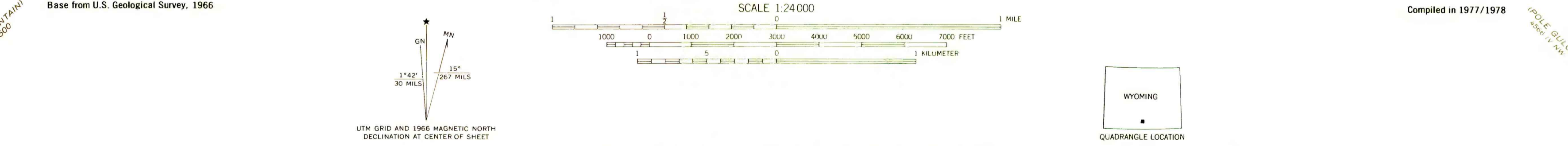
