POINT OF MEASUREMENT - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Includes all points of measurement other than drill holes.

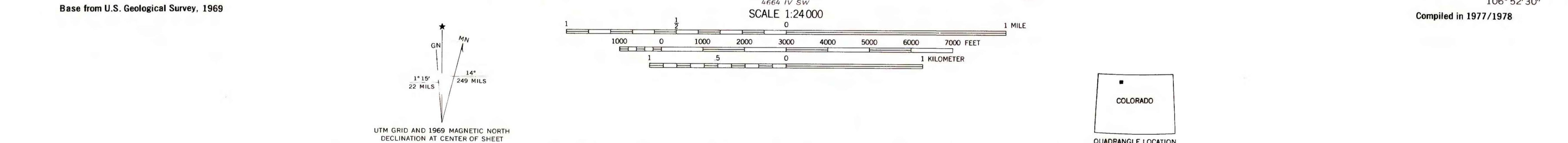

TRACE OF FAULT - Bar and ball on down-thrown side when direction of movement is known. Dashed where inferred or approximately located.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
