**NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND**—Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights.

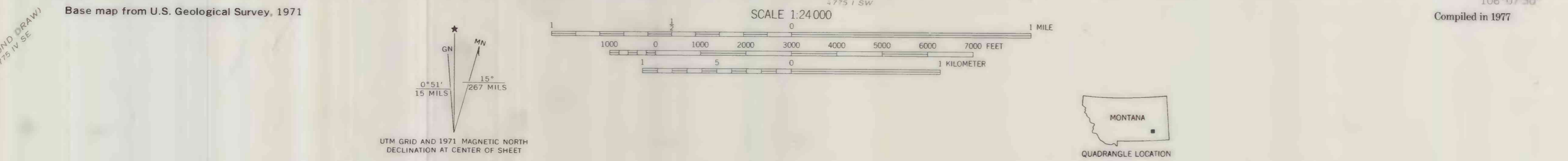
