EXPLANATION

ISOPACHS - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Isopach interval 1 foot.

STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of coal bed. Solid where vertical accuracy within 40 feet; long dashed where vertical accuracy possibly not within 40 feet; short dashed where projected above ground surface. Contour interval is 100 feet (61 m). Datum is mean sea level.

DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude of top of coal bed, and thickness of coal, in feet.
