

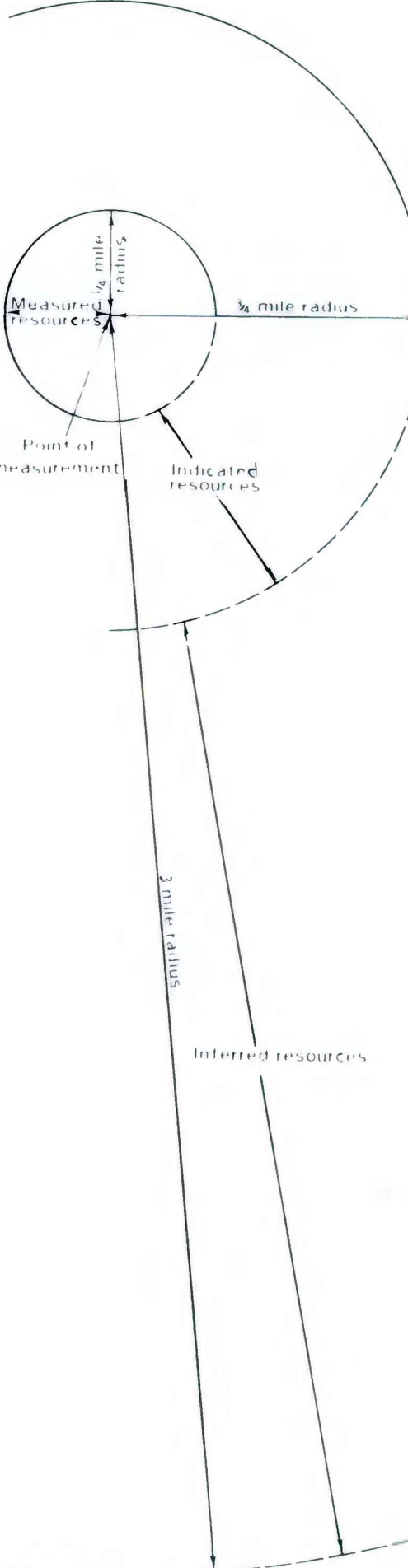
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EXPLANATION

NON-FEDERAL COAL—Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights.

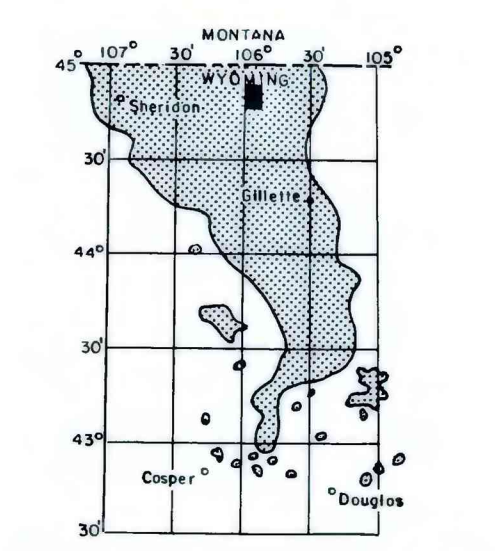
COAL LEASE (Coal Lec.)—An area of Federal coal lands in which the Federal Government has entered into a contractual agreement for the development of the coal deposits.

STRIPPING-LIMIT LINE—Boundary for surface mining of coal bed (in this quadrangle, the 500-foot-overburden isopach). Arrows point toward the area suitable for surface mining. Recovery factor of 95 percent within that area in this quadrangle.



BOUNDARY LINES—Enclosing areas of measured, indicated, and inferred coal resources of the coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles. Hypothetical resources beyond 3 miles.

To convert miles to kilometers multiply miles by 1.609.
