



EXPLANATION

ISOPACHS OF THE COAL BED—Showing thickness, in
feet. Isopach interval 1 foot.

BOUNDARY OF COAL DEPOSIT—Drawn along the
outcrop of coal bed and/or the contact between burned
and unburned coal (dashed where inferred by present
author beyond the limits of original data). Arrows point
toward coal-bearing area. Number is thickness, in feet,
of coal bed measured at triangle. Plus (+) sign after
number indicates incomplete measurement.


To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
