


STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed. Contour interval 20 feet. Datum is mean sea level.

DRILL HOLE—Showing elevation at top of coal bed, in feet.



INFERRED POINT—Derived from outcrop elevation plus coal thickness, showing elevation in feet.


