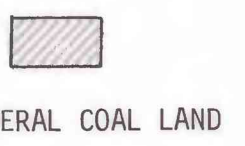
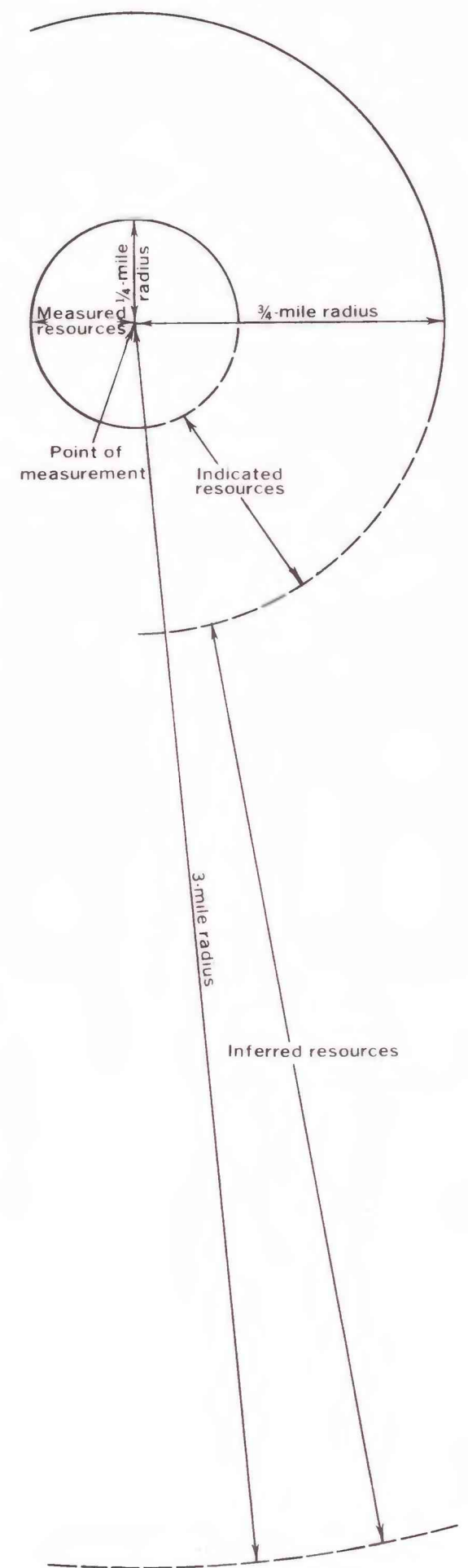

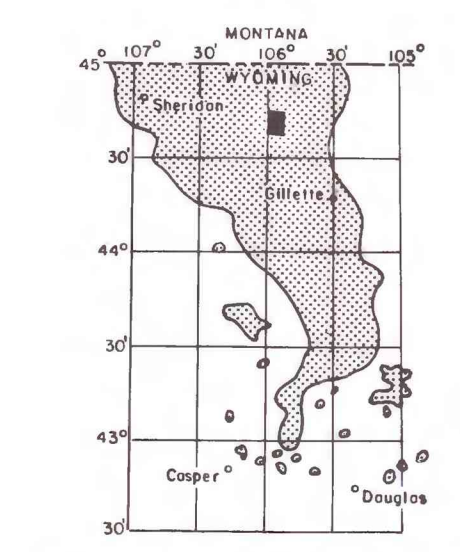


STRIPPING LIMIT LINE—500

multiply miles by 1,609.

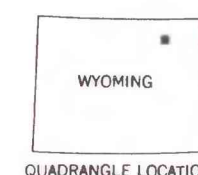
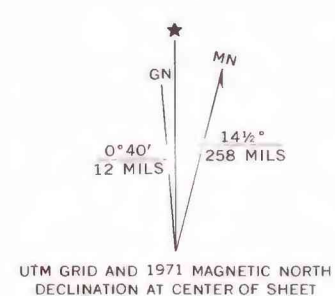


MAP SHOWING LOCATION OF THE
