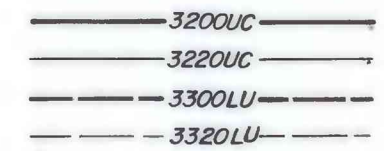

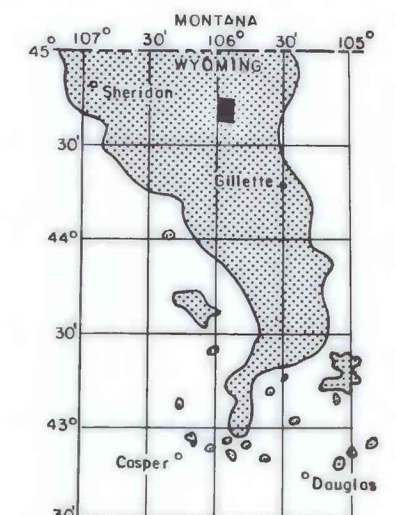


STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed. Contour interval 20 feet. Datum is mean sea level.

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.

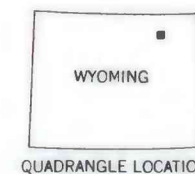
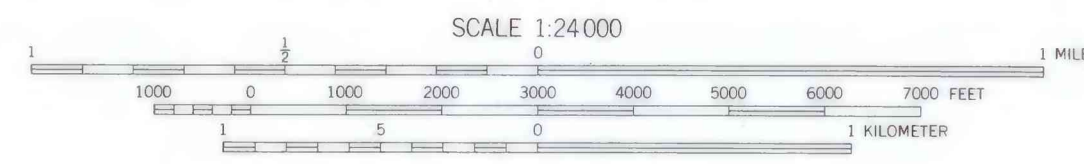
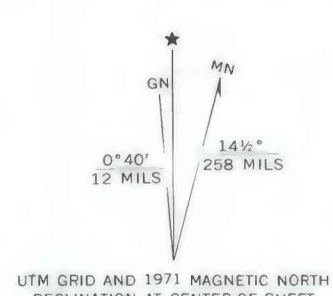
