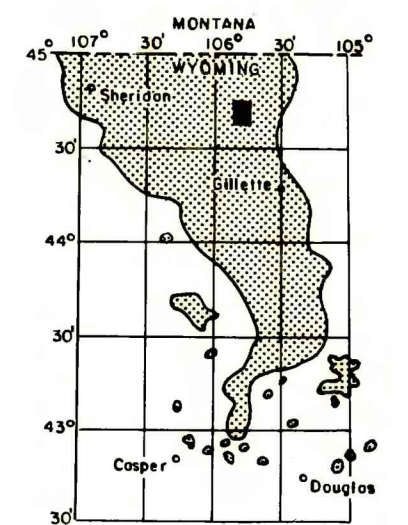
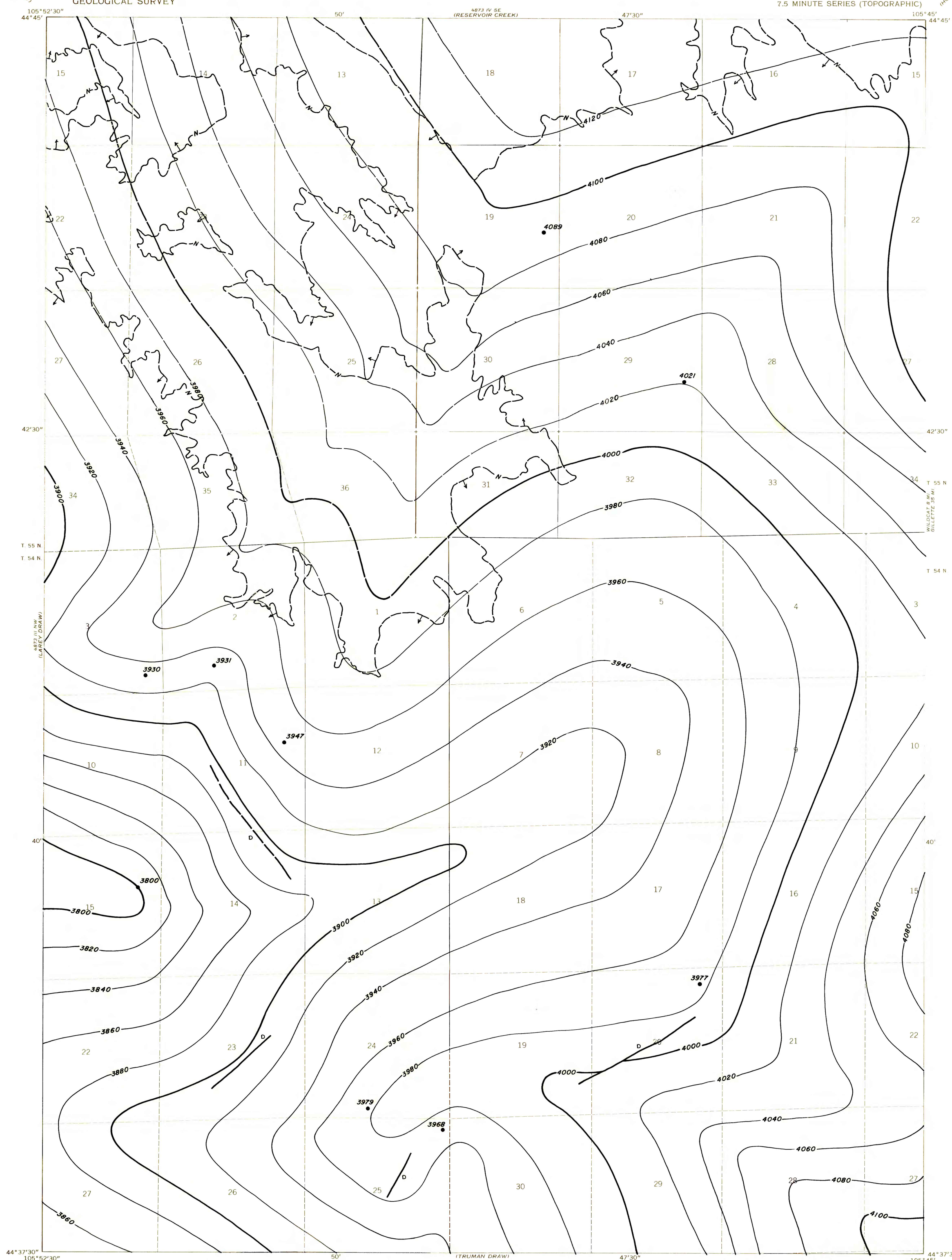

DRILL HOLE—Showing elevation at top of coal bed, in feet.



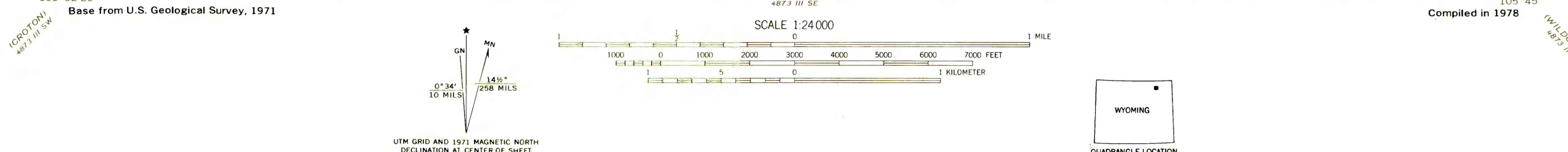
TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP—Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area.
