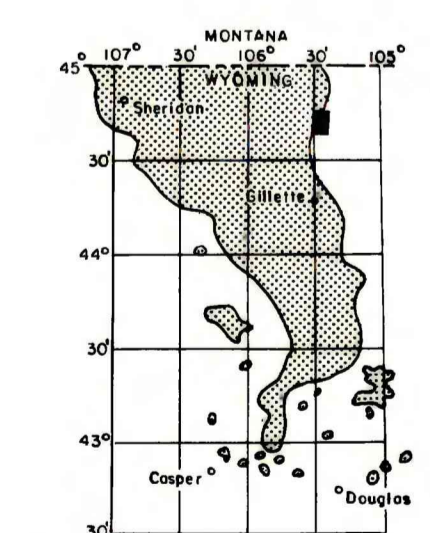

To convert short tons to metric tonnes, multiply short tons by 0.9072.



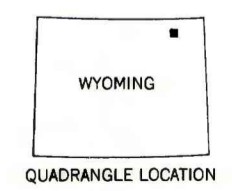
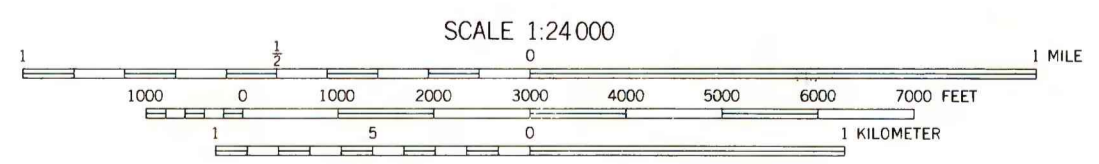
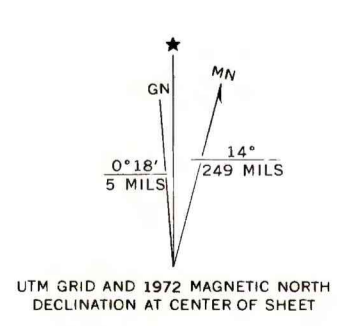
