


NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND

BOUNDARY LINES— Enclosing areas of measured, indicated and inferred coal resources of the coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles. Hypothetical resources beyond 3 miles.

To convert miles to kilometers multiply miles by 1.609.



