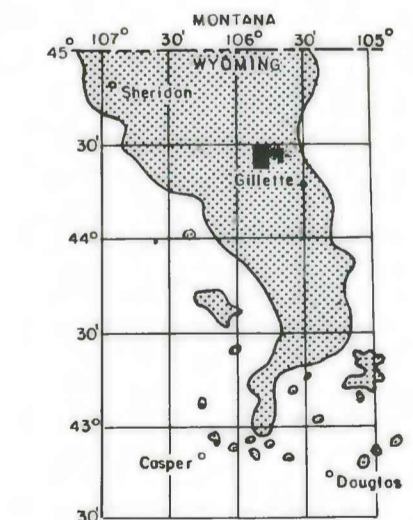
NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND—Coal tonnages not evaluated.

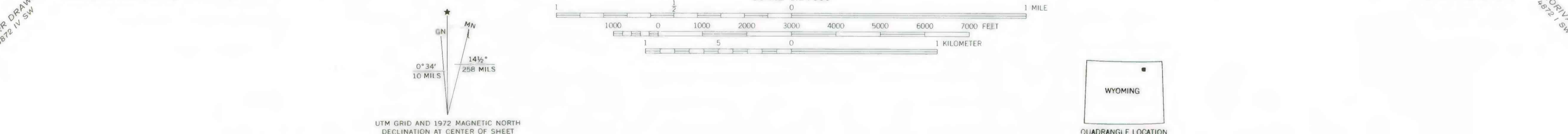
IDENTIFIED RESOURCES OF COAL BED—In millions of short tons. Dash indicates no resources in that category.
