



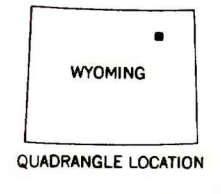
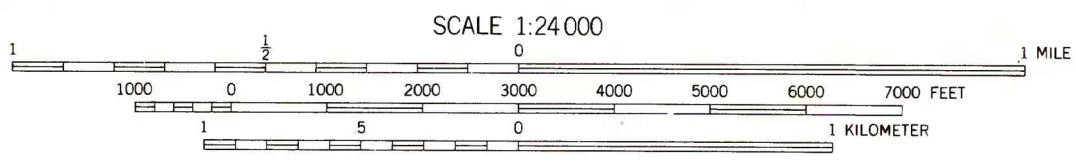
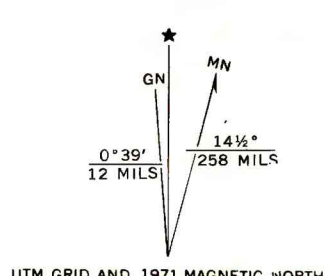


EXPLANATION
