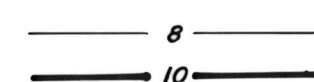

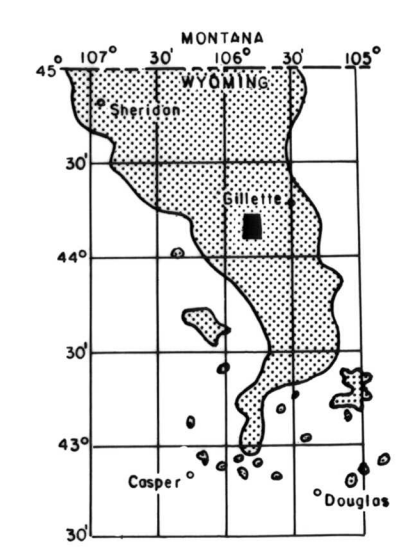
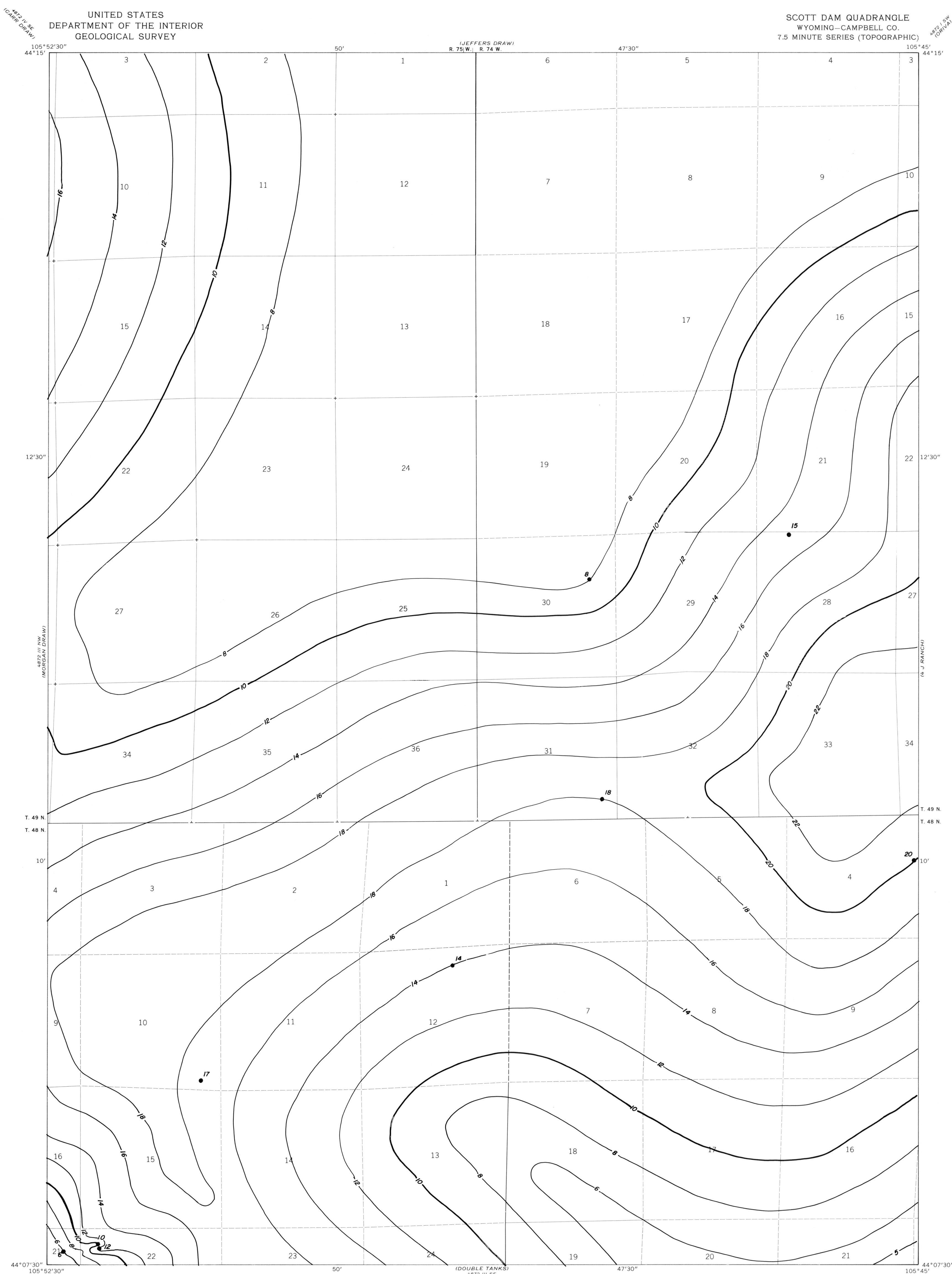


ISOPACHS OF COAL BED—Showing thickness in feet, interval 2 feet, with intermediate 5 foot contour.



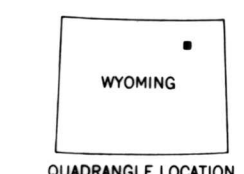
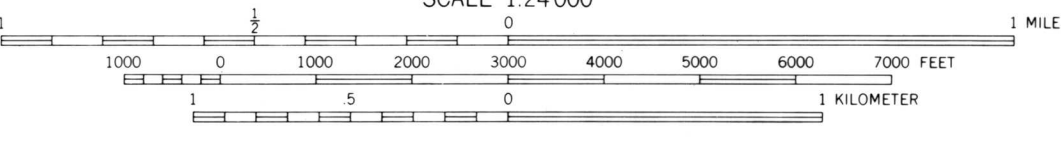
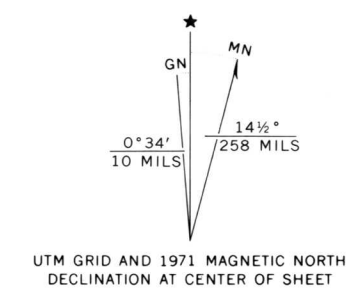
DRILL HOLE—Showing coal thickness in feet.
