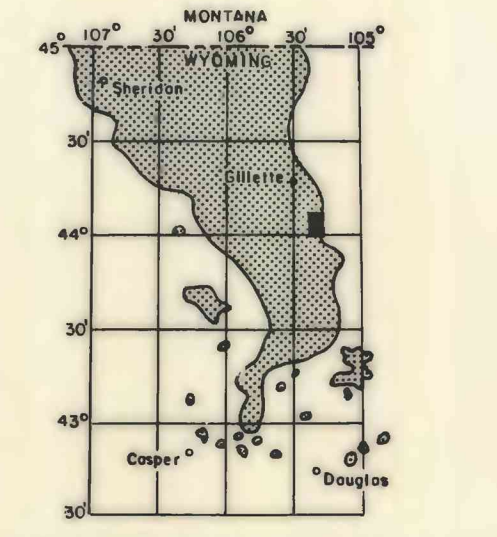

DRILL HOLE—Showing thickness of overburden, in feet, from the surface to top of coal bed.

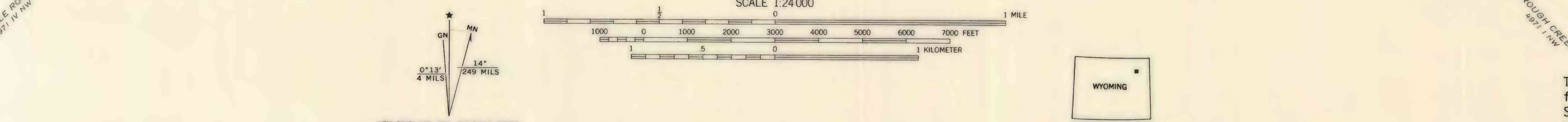
