




TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP-Arrow points to the coal-bearing area. Coal bed dashed where inferred.

To convert miles to kilometers multiply miles by 1.609.



This outcrop mapping is derived and enlarged from a 1:126,720 scale publication from Wegemann and others (1928, Plate 3). Numerous irregularities in outcrop elevations and the areal geology-topographic map relationship emphasize that this map presents a generalized configuration of the coal bed outcrop. Horizontal accuracy of outcrop location is estimated at  $\pm 1000$  feet (305 m).
