

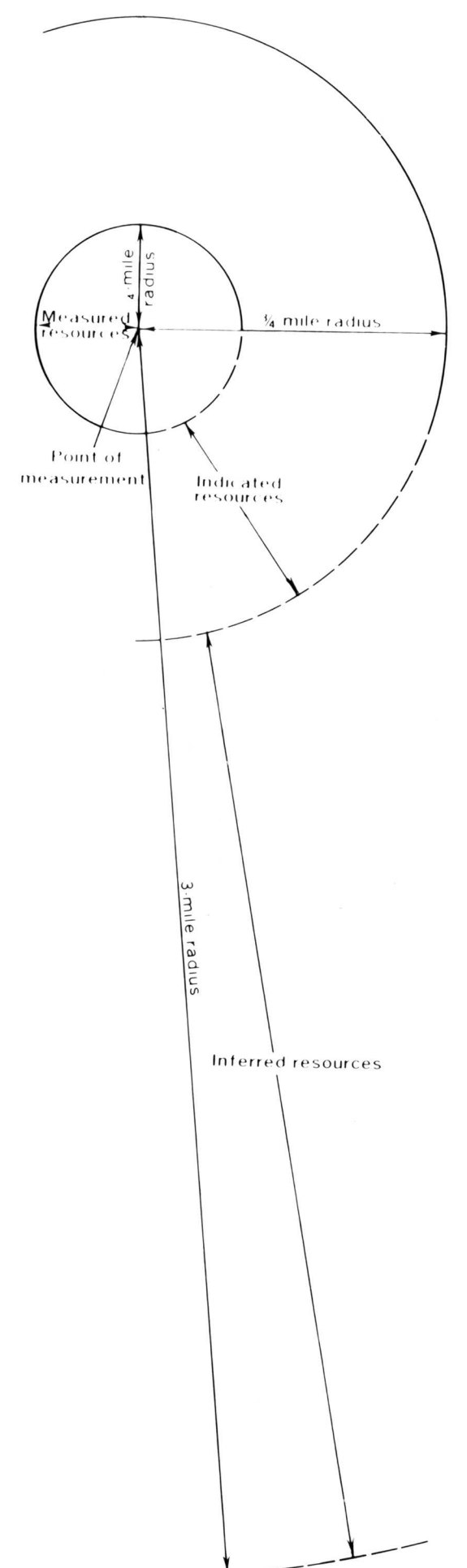

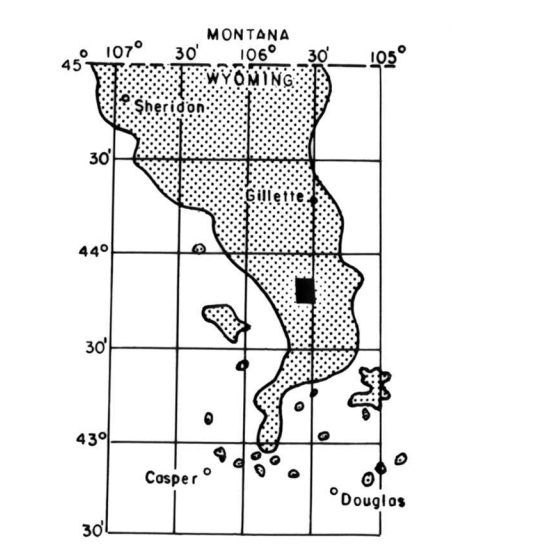
TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP—Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Coal bed dashed where inferred.

This outcrop mapping is derived and enlarged from a 1:126,720 scale publication (Wegemann and others, 1928, p. 1-14). Numerous irregularities in outcrop elevations and the areal geology-topographic map relationship emphasize that this map presents a generalized configuration of the coal bed outcrop. Horizontal accuracy of outcrop location is estimated at ± 1000 feet (305 m).



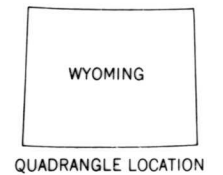
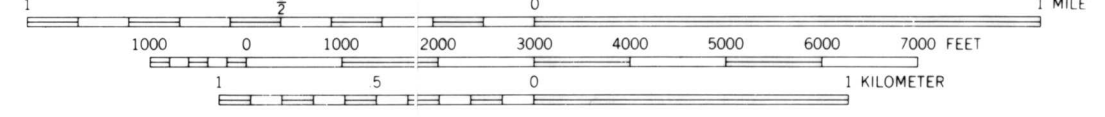
BOUNDARY LINES—Enclosing areas of measured, indicated and inferred coal resources of the coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles.
