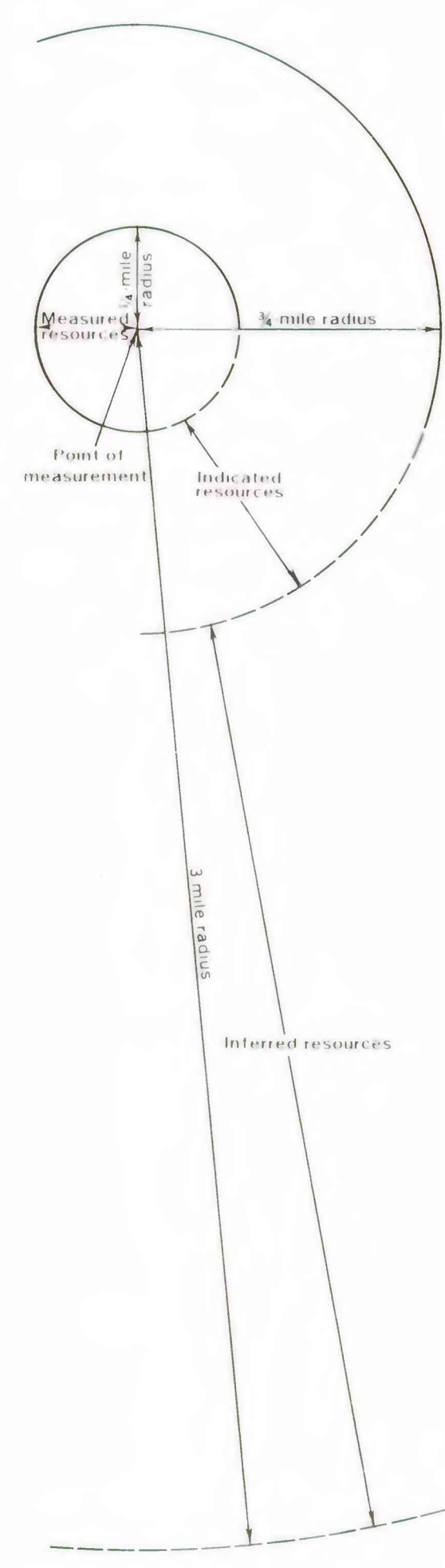

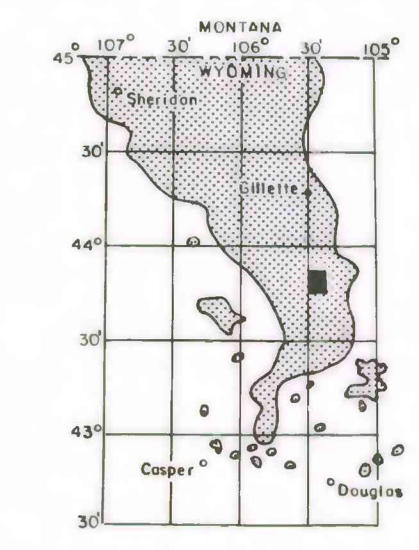
NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND

STRIPPING LIMIT LINE-500 foot overburden isopach boundary for surface mining of coal. Arrow indicates area suitable for surface mining.

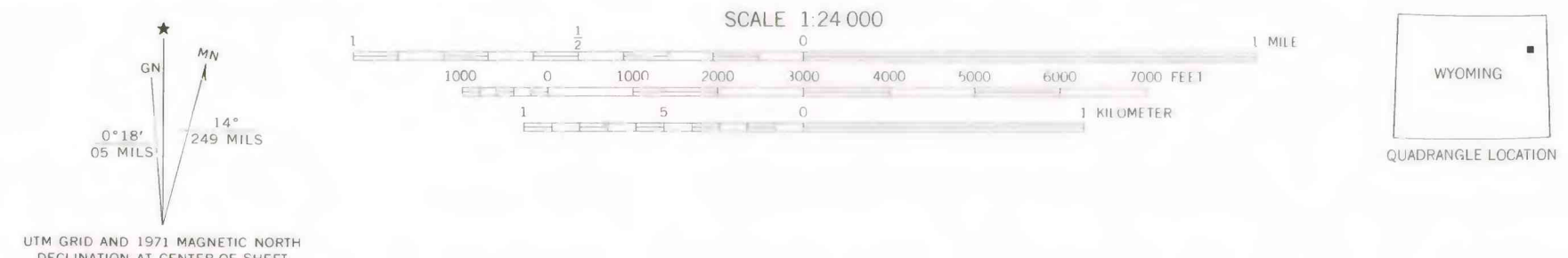
