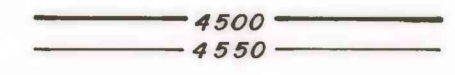

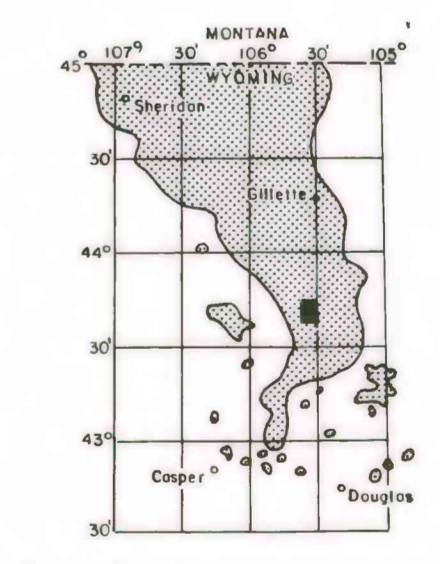


STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed. Contour interval 50 feet. Datum is mean sea level.

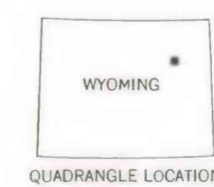
