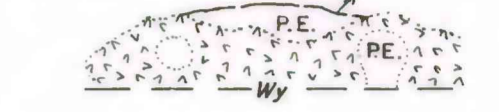

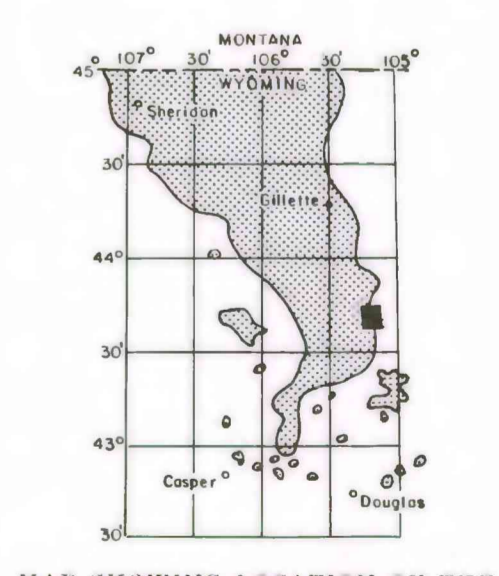

DRILL HOLE—Showing elevation at top of coal bed, in feet.

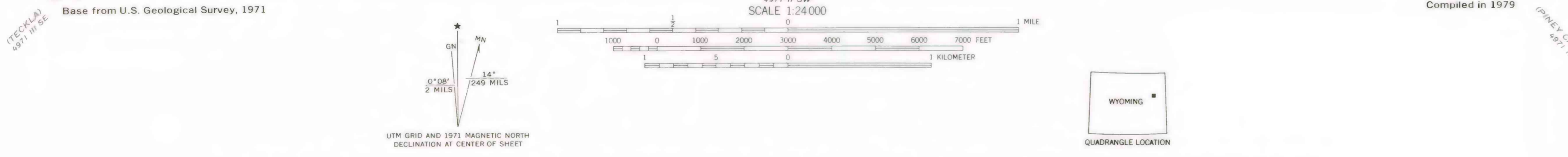
