Isopach interval 1 foot (0.3 m). Not shown where coal is thinner than 5 feet (1.5 m).

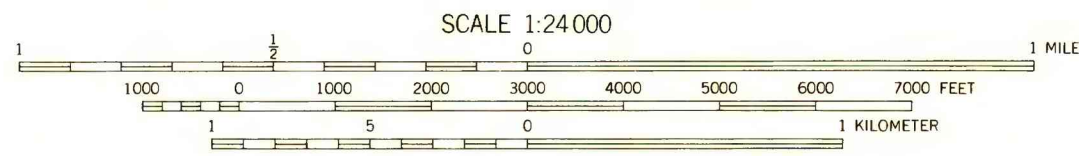
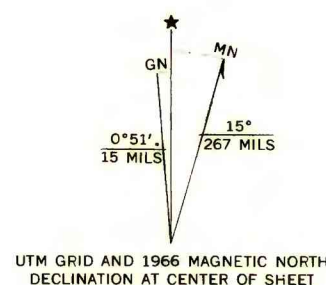
BOUNDARY OF RESERVE BASE COAL--Drawn along the 5-foot coal isopach. Arrows point toward area of Reserve Base coal.
