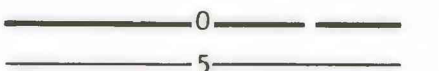


EXPLANATION



ISOPACHS OF THE FRUITLAND 3 COAL BED - Showing thickness, in feet. Isopach interval 5 feet (1.5 meters). Isopachs dashed where projected through noncoal-bearing area.

DRILL HOLE - Showing thickness of the Fruitland 3 coal bed, in feet.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing symbol of name of coal bed. Arrow points to coal-bearing area. Dashed line indicates inferred outcrop. Trace of coal bed outcrop modified (from original data source) to fit modern topographic map.

FAULT - Dashed where approximately located; bar and ball on downthrown side.

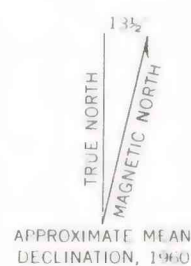
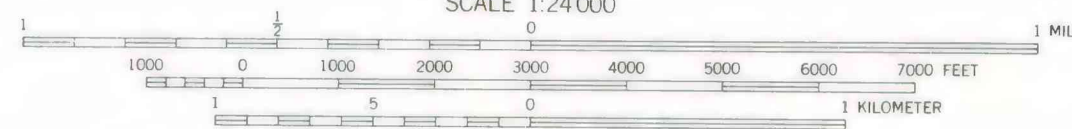
To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
