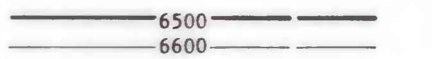


EXPLANATION

DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude of top of coal bed, in feet.

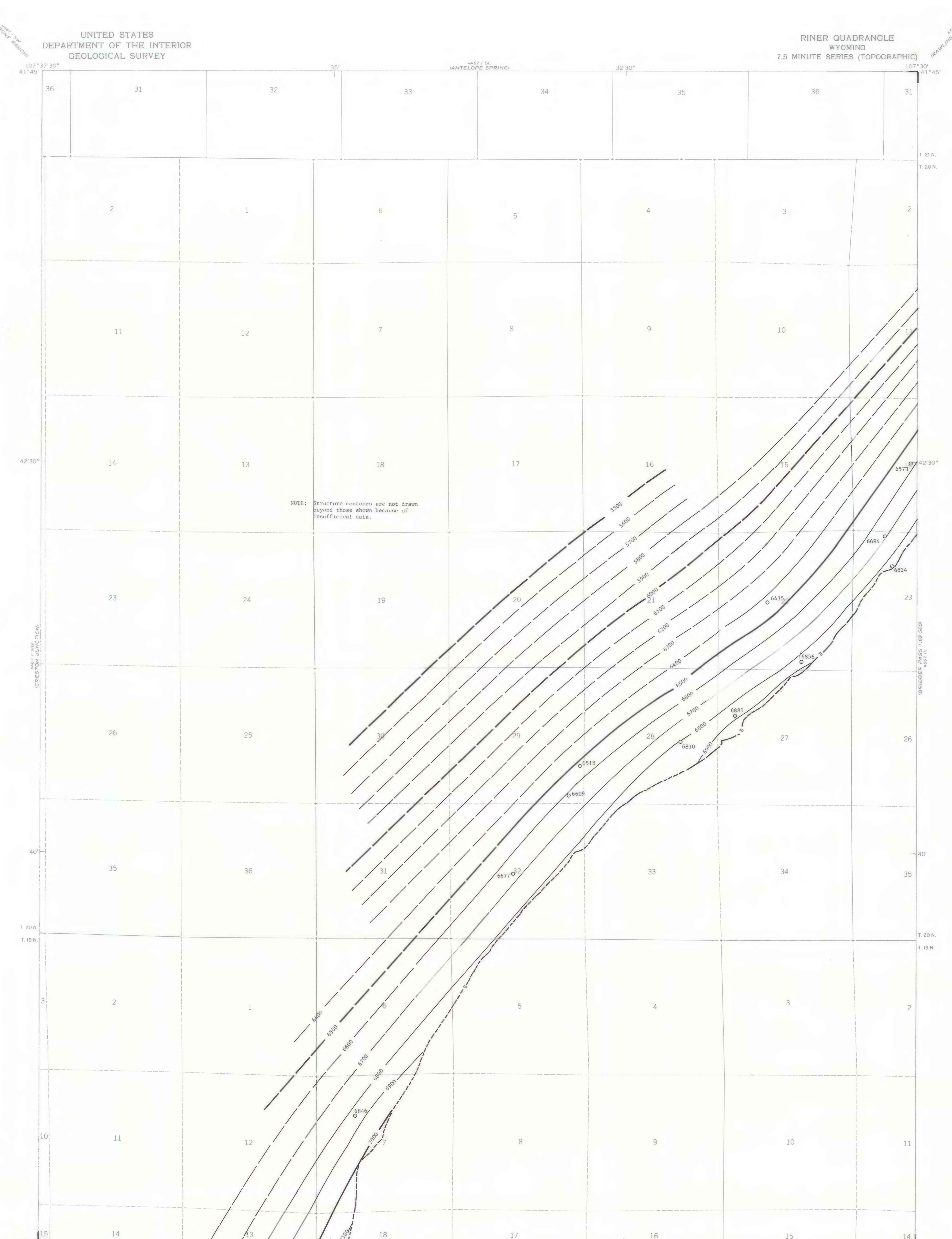
B - B (Fillmore Ranch) of Lower Fort Union Coal Zone

To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.

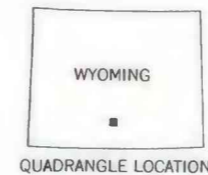
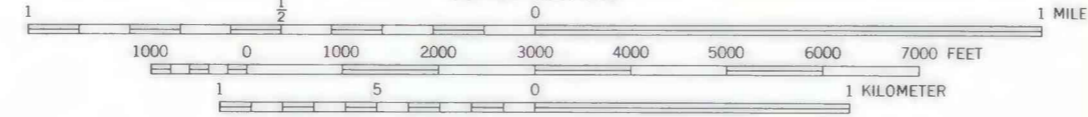
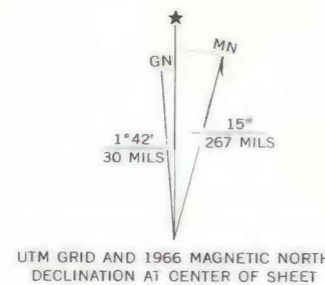
