STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of coal bed. Solid where vertical accuracy within 40 feet; long dashed where vertical accuracy possibly not within 40 feet; short dashed where projected above ground surface. Contour interval is 100 feet (30.5 m). Datum is mean sea level.

FR - Fillmore Ranch (B) of Lower Fort Union Coal Zone




COAL BED SYMBOL AND NAME
