



EXPLANATION

- ISOPACHS - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Long dashed where inferred. Isopach interval 1 foot.
 - STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of coal bed. Solid where vertical accuracy within 40 feet; long dashed where vertical accuracy possibly not within 40 feet. Contour interval is 200 feet (61.0 m). Datum is mean sea level.
 - DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude of top of coal bed, and thickness of coal, in feet.
 - Av-4C - Adaville No. 4C
COAL BED SYMBOL AND NAME
 - TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing symbol of name of coal bed as listed above. Arrow points toward coal-bearing area. Dashed where inferred; short dashed where inferred by present authors.
 - TRACE OF AXIAL PLANE OF ASYMMETRIC SYNCLINE AT DEPTH - Short arrow indicates steeper limb.
