ISOPACHS - Showing thickness of coal, in feet. Isopach interval 5 feet.

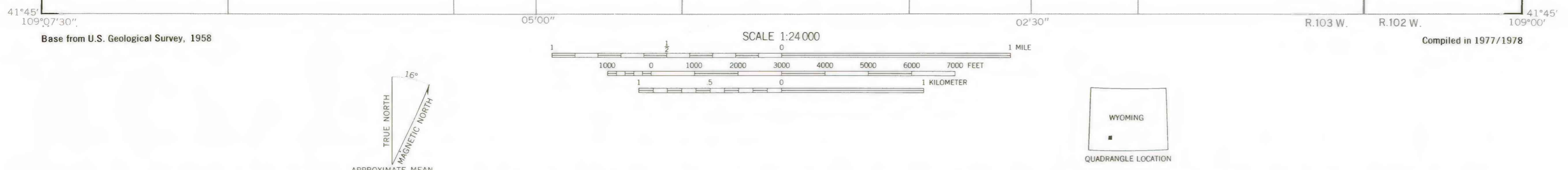
