

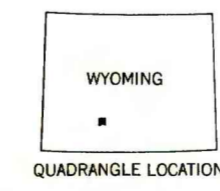
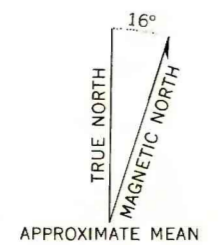
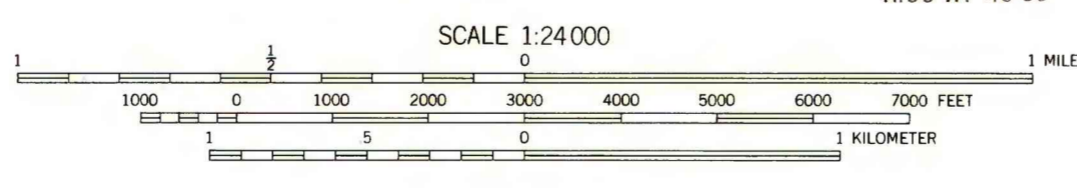
EXPLANATION
