 NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights, and for which the coal development potential is not rated.



 AREA OF LOW COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas underlain by coal of the Fruitland I and Fruitland zone A beds. Area has mining-ratio values greater than 15.

 AREA OF UNKNOWN COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas with coal thickness less than 5 feet (1.5 m).

 AREA OF NO COAL DEVELOPMENT POTENTIAL FOR SURFACE MINING METHODS - Includes areas beyond the stripping limit and outside the outcrop.

Unpatterned areas are PRLA lands.
