STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of the Fruitland coal zone, which is coincident with the top of the uppermost Fruitland zone coal bed. Contour interval 100 feet (30.5 meters). Datum is mean sea level. Contours long dashed where inferred, short dashed where projected through noncoal-bearing area.

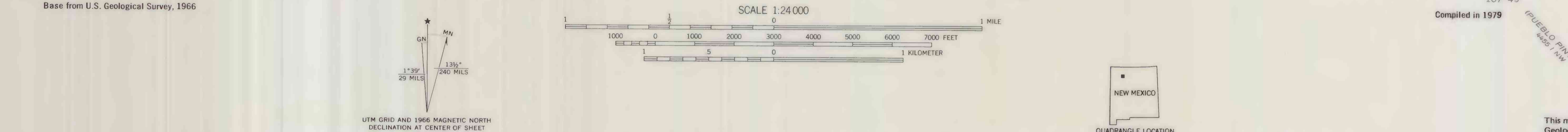
DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude at the top of the Fruitland coal zone, in feet.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP - Showing symbol of name of coal bed. Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Dashed line indicates inferred outcrop. Trace of coal bed outcrop modified (from original data source) to fit modern topographic map.

FAULT - Dashed where approximately located; bar and bell on downthrown side.
