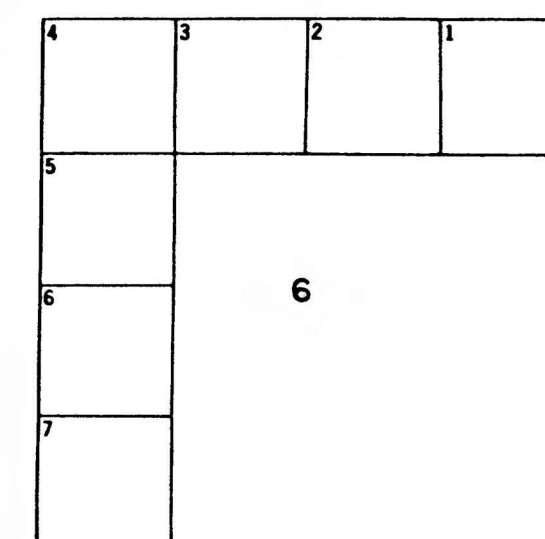


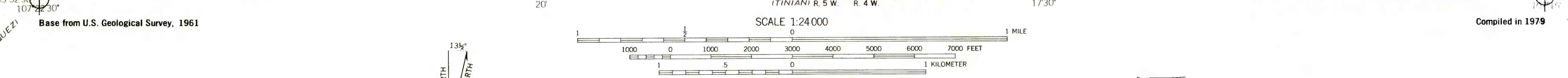
EXPLANATION

- NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND - Land within the KRCRA boundary for which the Federal Government does not own the coal rights.

REFERENCE RIGHT LEASE APPLICATION (PRLA) - An area of Federal coal lands for which an application for a non-competitive coal lease has been made as a result of exploration done under a coal prospecting permit.
- RB 7.10  
TOTAL RESERVE BASE (RB) OF FEDERAL COAL PER SECTION - In millions of short tons, calculated for each section of Federal land following the guidelines given in U.S. Geological Survey Bulletin 1450-B. To convert short tons to metric tons, multiply short tons by 0.9072.
