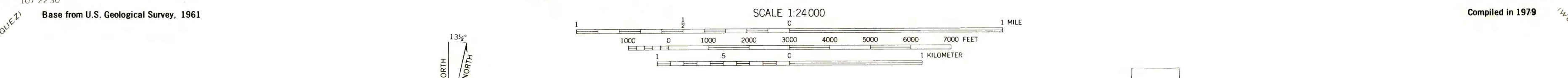


**EXPLANATION**

- STRUCTURE CONTOURS - Drawn on top of the Fruitland I coal bed. Contour interval 100 feet (30.5 meters). Datum is mean sea level. Contours long dashed where latered, short dashed where projected through noncoal-bearing area.

DRILL HOLE - Showing altitude at the top of the Fruitland I coal bed, in feet.
- Fr 1
- TRACE OF COAL BED OCCURRENCE - Showing symbol of name of coal bed. Arrow points to coal-bearing area. Dashed line indicates latered outcrop; dotted where noncoal-bearing. Trace of coal bed outcrop modified (from original data source) to fit modern topographic map.
- FAULT - Dashed where approximately located; bar and ball on downthrown side.
- To convert feet to meters, multiply feet by 0.3048.
- Fruitland coal beds contoured on a single surface on this map are equivalent in stratigraphic position but may not be continuous.
