



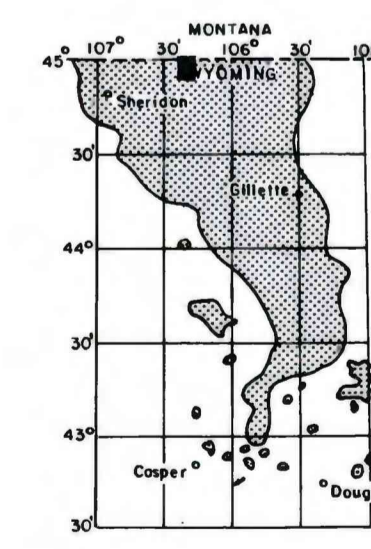

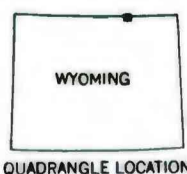
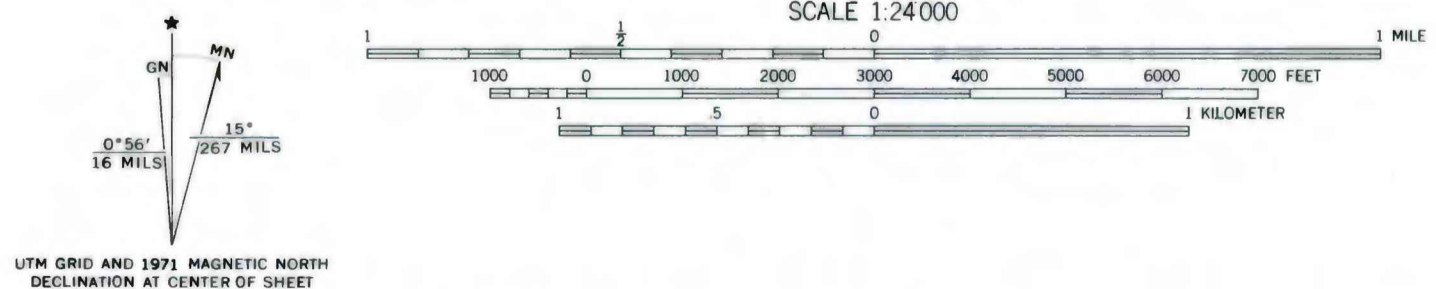
MAP SHOWING LOCATION OF THE BOX
