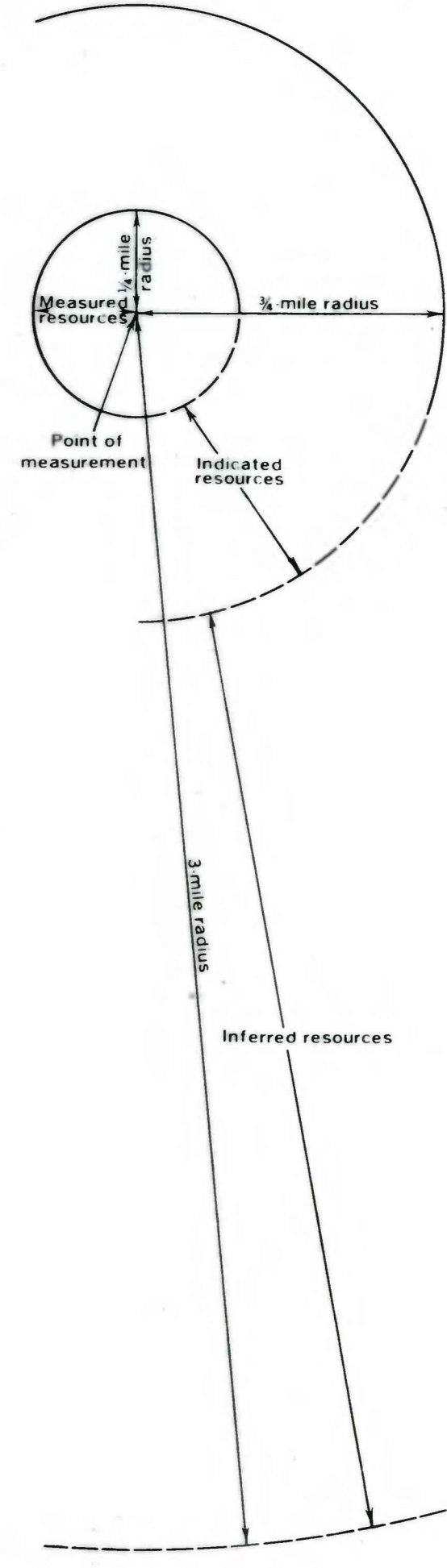

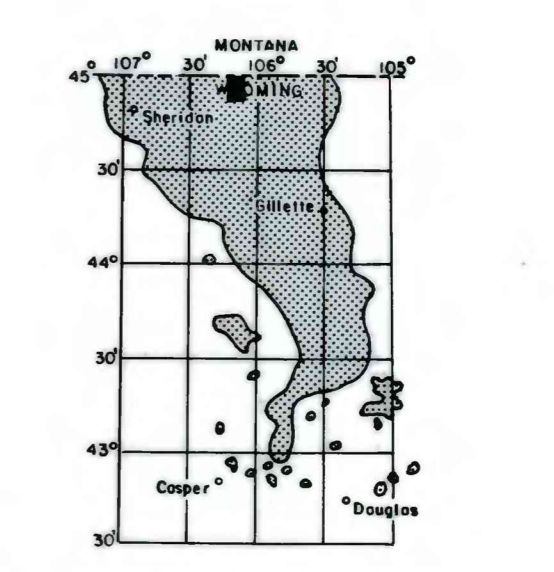
NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND-Coal tonnages not evaluated.

BOUNDARY LINES-Enclosing areas of measured, indicated and inferred coal resources of the coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles.

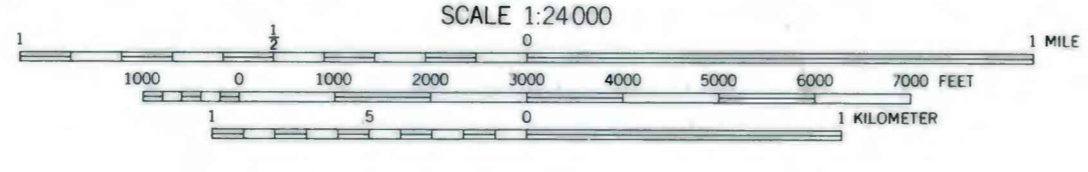
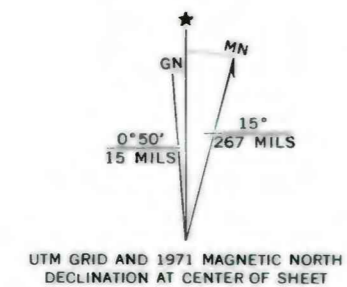
