

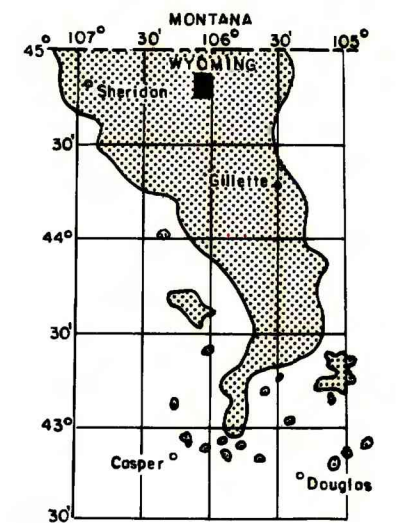

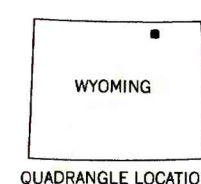
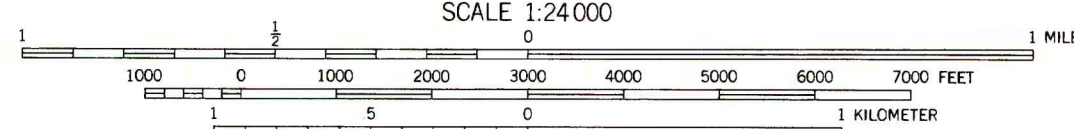
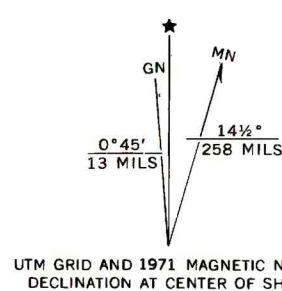
MAP SHOWING LOCATION OF THE
