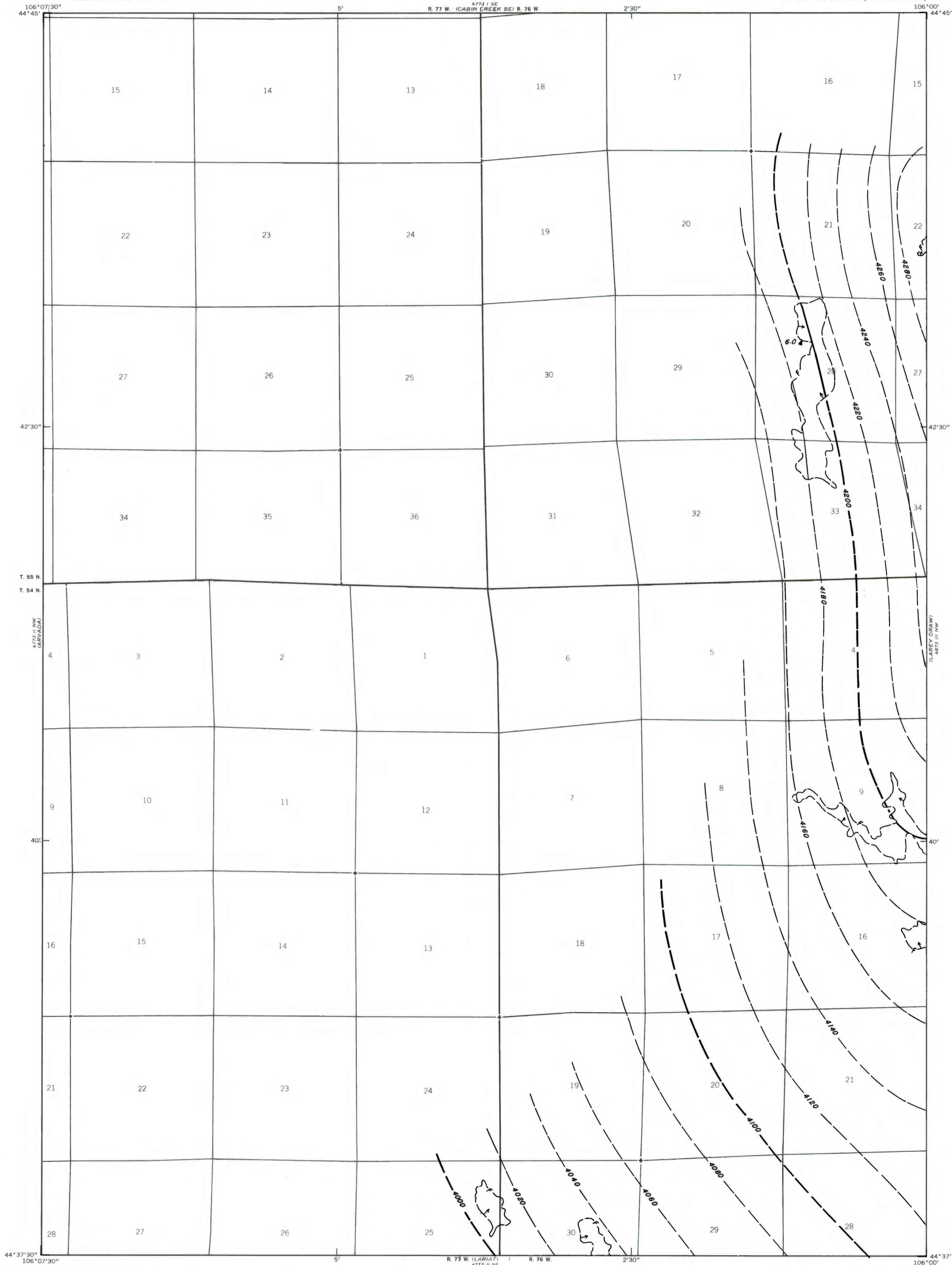




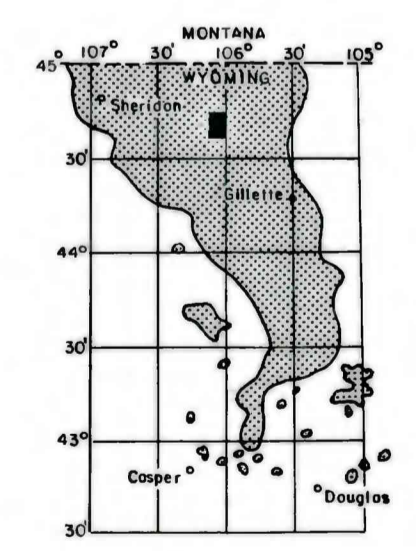

 TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP—Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Coal bed dashed where inferred or projected.

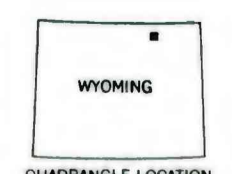
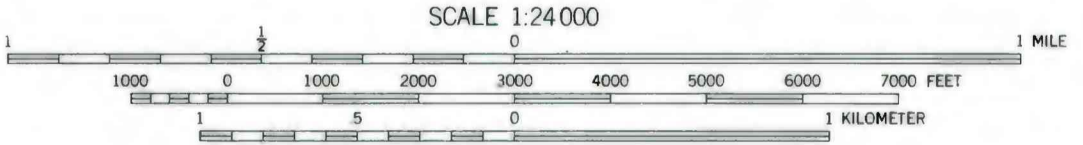
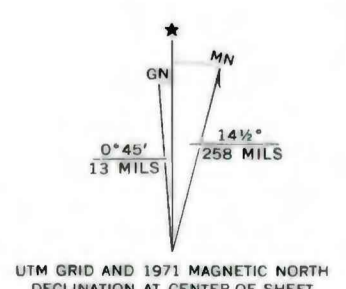
