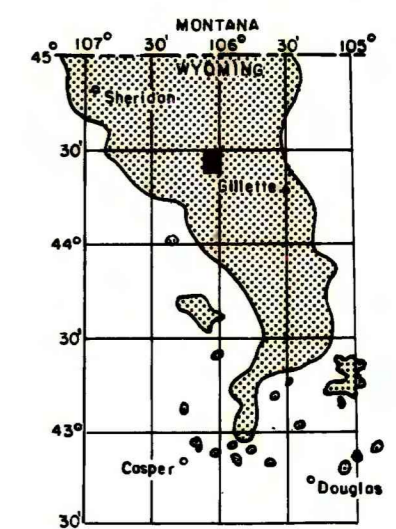

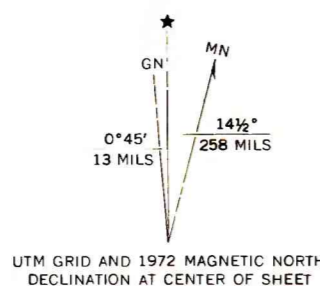
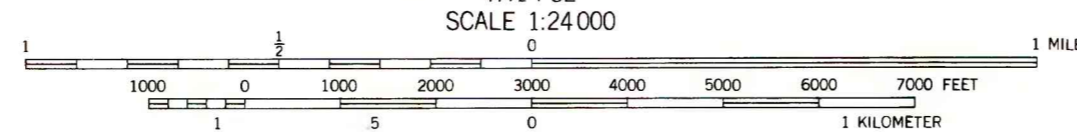
— 300 —
