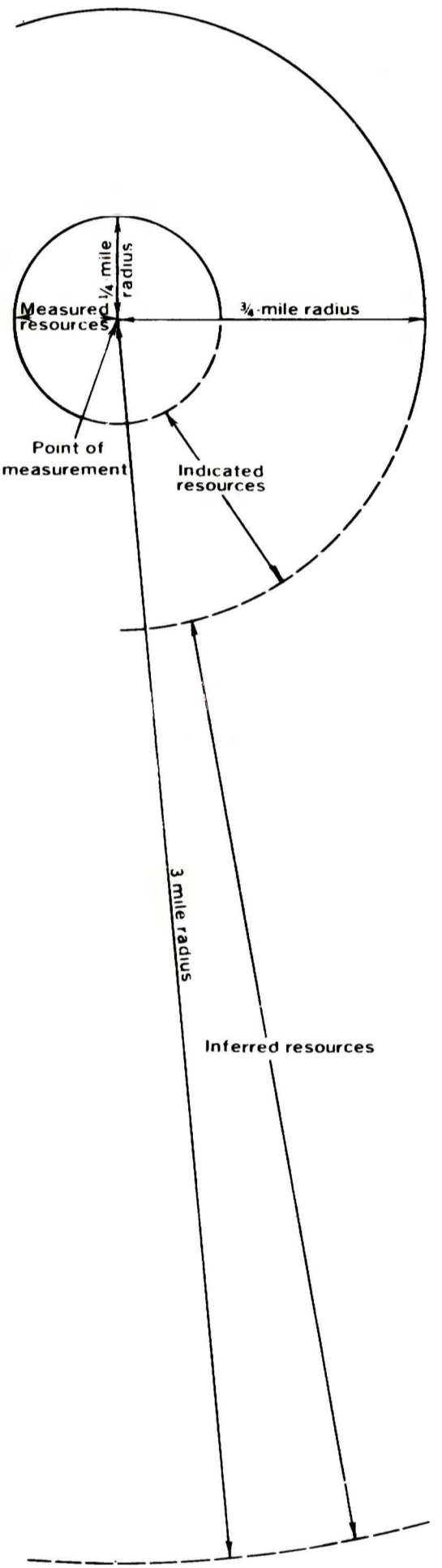


EXPLANATION

NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND-Coal tonnages not evaluated.

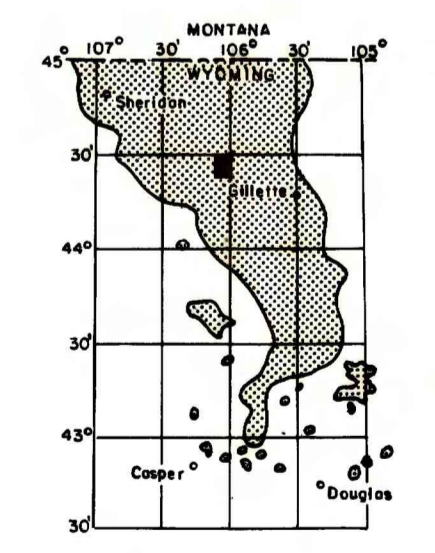
STRIPPING LIMIT LINE-500 foot overburden isopach boundary for surface mining of coal. Arrow indicates area suitable for surface mining.

TRACE OF COAL BED OUTCROP-Arrow points toward the coal-bearing area. Coal bed dashed where inferred or projected.

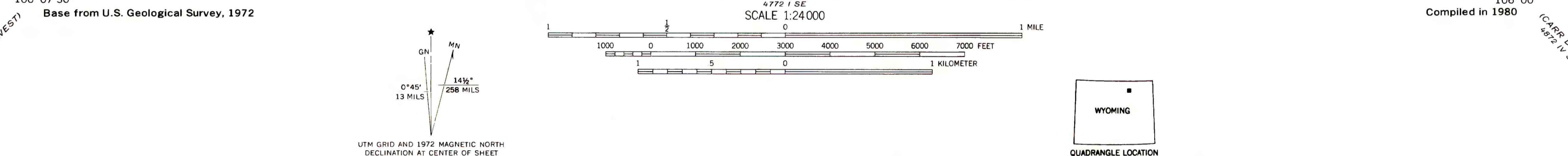


BOUNDARY LINES-Enclosing areas of measured, indicated and inferred coal resources of the coal bed. Dashed where projected from adjacent quadrangles. Hypothetical resources beyond 3 miles.
