

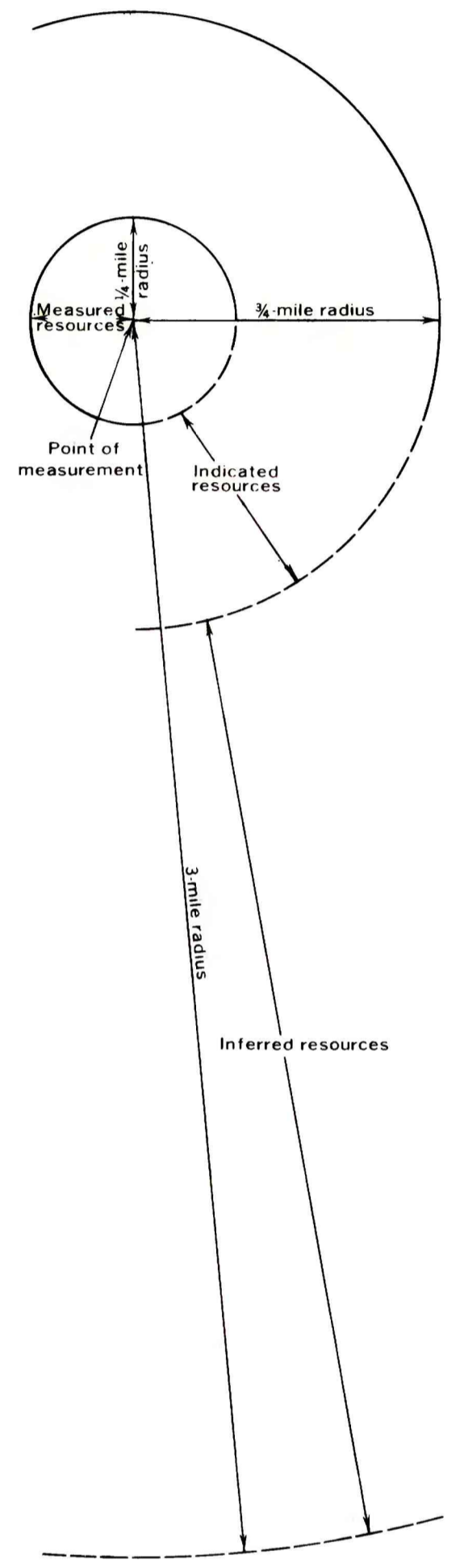

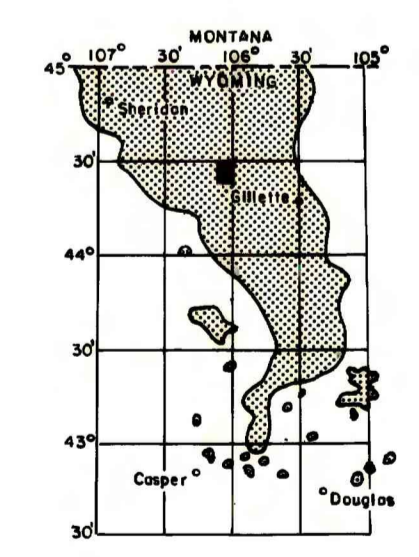
 NON-FEDERAL COAL LAND-Coal tonnages not evaluated.

 STRIPPING LIMIT LINE-500 foot overburden isopach boundary for surface mining of coal. Arrow indicates area suitable for surface mining.



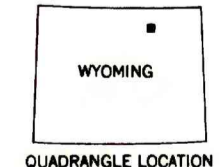
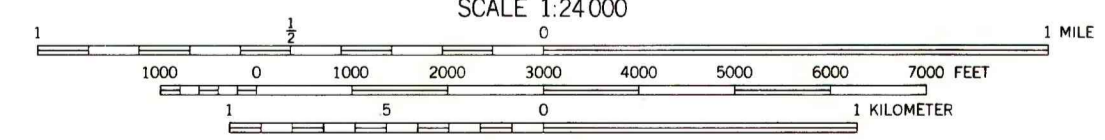
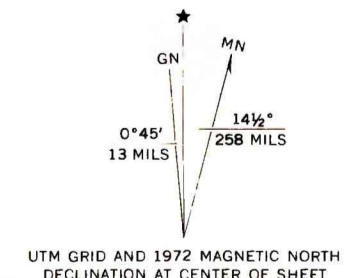
