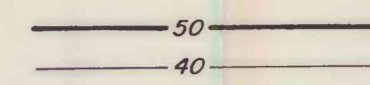

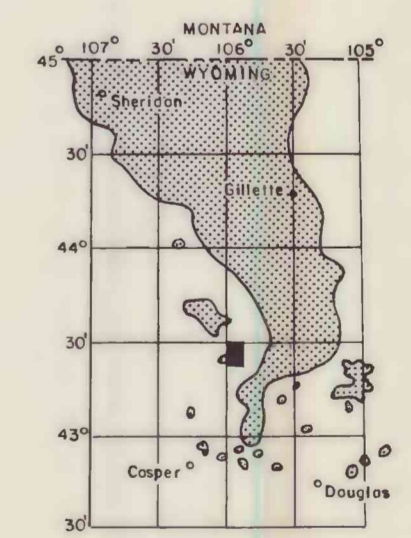


ISOPACHS OF COAL BED—Showing thickness in feet, interval 10 feet, with 5 foot intermediate contour.



DRILL HOLE—Showing coal thickness in feet.

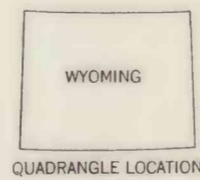
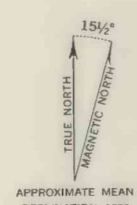
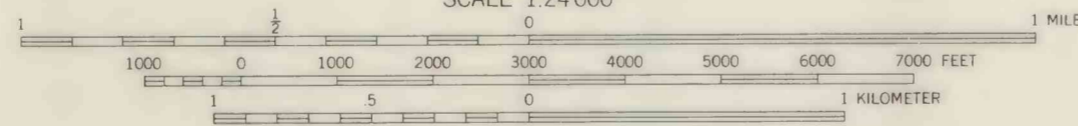
