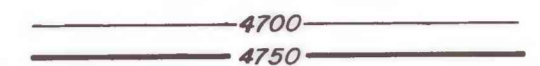

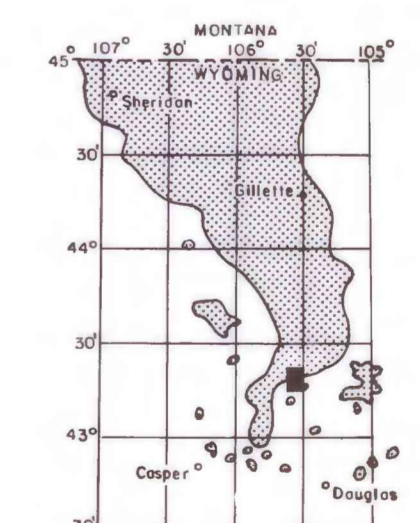


STRUCTURE CONTOURS—Drawn on top of coal bed. Contour interval 50 feet. Datum is mean sea level.

To convert feet to meters multiply feet by 0.3048.



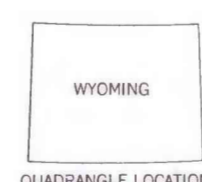
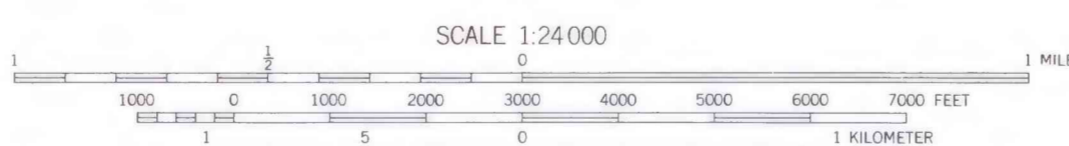
