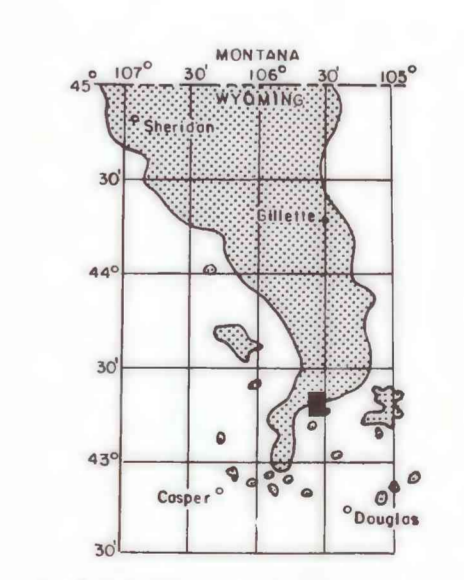
KNOWN RECOVERABLE COAL RESOURCE AREA—KRCRA
